# **NORTH INDIA EMERGENCY FLOOD RELIEF**

**UPDATE 2** 28 JULY, 2023









### Situation of the North India Flood

Since mid-July 2023, the northern states of India have been grappling with a deluge of heavy rains. Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, and Uttarakhand have been severely affected by this natural calamity. Tragically, it has resulted in the loss of over 189 lives, with many others reported missing and displaced. Additionally, there has been significant

damage to properties and infrastructure in the affected regions. The situation remains critical as authorities and relief agencies continue their efforts to provide aid and support to the affected communities.

## **EFICOR's Response:**

In response to the dire situation caused by the heavy rains and flooding in the northern states of India, EFICOR has swiftly acted by deploying a dedicated team. Their efforts are focused on providing aid and support in four states: Delhi, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Photo by EFICOR: Beneficiary list finalisation, Delhi and Uttarakhand.

After conducting a rapid assessment of the situation on the ground, the team has made a comprehensive plan to reach out to those in need. EFICOR aims to assist a total of 5000 households in the affected regions. To achieve this, it has been decided to provide unconditional cash support of INR 3,500/to 3000 families in Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, and Uttarakhand. And to distribute food and nonfood materials to 2000 affected families in Delhi and NCR. This concerted effort by EFICOR is expected to bring much-needed relief to the affected communities, helping them cope with the devastating impact of the floods and support the affected families to restoration process.

In the past week, EFICOR took swift action and initiated its first response by distributing 270 hygiene kits to the communities affected in the Usmanpur area of North East Delhi. These hygiene kits are intended to promote health and sanitation among the affected population, helping to prevent the spread of waterborne diseases and maintain personal hygiene amidst difficult conditions.

## **Updates for the Week**

• The Emergency Relief Team (ERT) has been proactive in responding to the situation. They have identified experienced staff from various projects and dispatched two-member teams to both Punjab and Himachal Pradesh. These teams are responsible for facilitating the process of unconditional cash transfers to those in need.

UPDATE 2 28 JULY, 2023

- In Delhi, a dedicated team comprising four members and four volunteers is actively working on the ground. Their primary task is to collect beneficiary details for the upcoming distribution of food and non-food items to the affected communities.
- The ERT has developed a comprehensive questionnaire for KoBo Survey, which will be used for both material distribution and unconditional cash transfers. The concerned staff involved in relief efforts have been trained on how to use this tool effectively.
- Additionally, the staff has undergone training on the relief code of conduct and other essential relief procedures to ensure smooth and ethical operations during the distribution process.
- In coordination with Delhi Movement, EFICOR staff assessed the affected communities in Preet Vihar, Delhi, to gain a better understanding of their needs and requirements.
- The ERT has taken steps to procure 270 kits containing both food and non-food items, which are essential for the affected families next week. These materials are currently being readied for distribution.
- Furthermore, the team has organized the printing of banners and relief distribution cards in preparation for a scheduled distribution in Delhi on 31st July 2023.
